# WHAT THIS FIELD GUIDE IS FOR

Clear communication across cultures and time zones requires intention. This field guide focuses on preventing misalignment in asynchronous and cross-cultural work.

## Why This Practice Matters in Client Work

Most misalignment comes from assumptions, not mistakes.]

Poor cross-cultural communication leads to:

- Missed expectations
- Frustration
- Unnecessary follow-ups
- Perceived unreliability

**Clear communication reduces friction and confusion.**

## Core Principles

- Clarity beats speed
- Silence does not equal agreement
- Expectations should be explicit
- Tone does not translate universally
- Assumptions create risk

# Common Failure Patterns

- Assuming shared context
- Vague timelines
- Overly informal language
- Ignoring time zone impact
- Misreading silence

**These are alignment issues, not effort issues.**

# Practical Approaches That Actually Work

## Setting Expectations

- State timelines explicitly
- Confirm understanding
- Avoid ambiguous phrasing

## Asynchronous Work

- Summarize key points
- Use clear next steps
- Document decisions

## Cultural Awareness

- Use neutral, respectful language
- Avoid idioms and slang
- Clarify intent when needed
